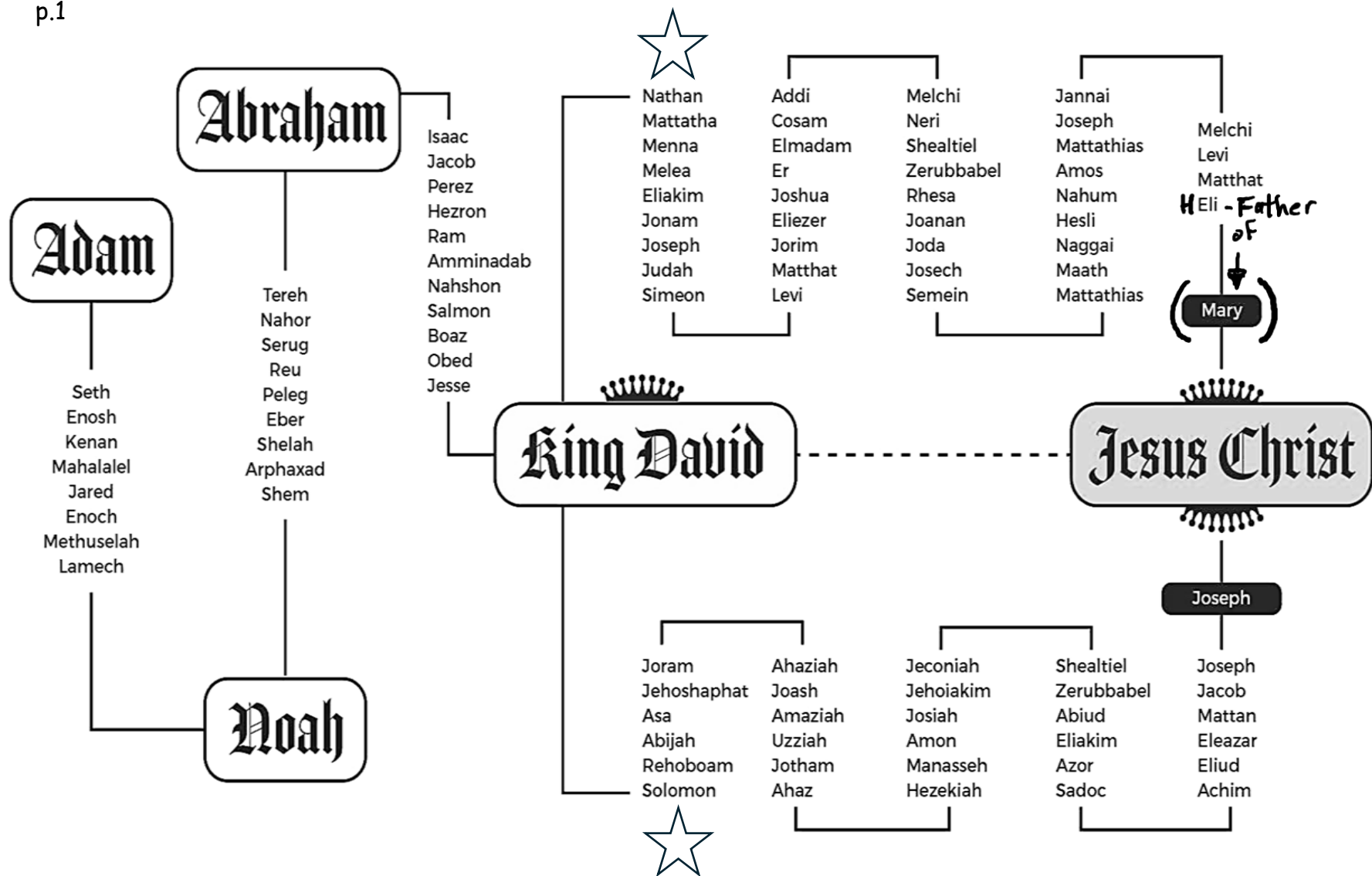
Matthew's genealogy diverges after David to Solomon and ends with Joseph. These are the kings of Judah.

This is the legal descent of Jesus - meaning Jesus is the legal heir to King David's throne.

Luke's genealogy diverges after David to Nathan, 2nd son of David & Bathsheba and ends with Heli, who was the father of Mary.

Women's names were not allowed. Heli would have adopted Joseph
