Heb. 11:24-27 By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, ²⁵ choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, ²⁶ esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward. ²⁷ By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible.

Stand at the Jordan: Are you willing to die to self, submit to God and enter God's rest?

Heb. 4:11 Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.

He will cause me to STAND in all circumstances.

As I am obedient in spiritual preparation, the Holy Spirit works in me and the Fullness of Jesus Christ is available to me for EVERY circumstance of my life.

Obedience and Faith in His Promises release God to work in me = Crack the Faith Barrier and Enter God's Rest.

- I long to be like you.

- He puts in me the longings, hunger and searching for Him- to be drawn to Him.
- He will enable me to carry out the absolute surrender.
